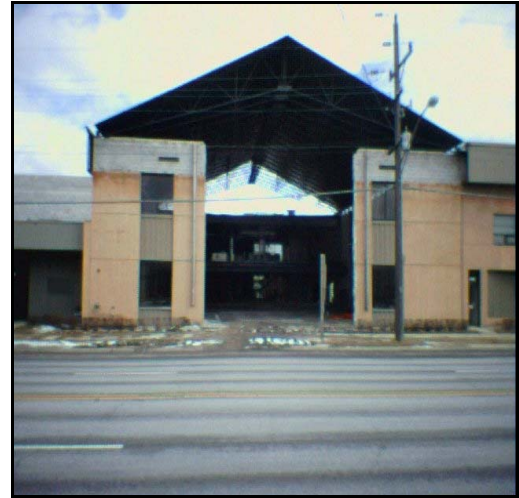


ROMANIAN BAPTIST CHURCH, DES PLAINES, ILLINOIS

Scissor trusses support a steel deck roof in the main sanctuary to provide the required clear span space and contribute to the dramatic effect of the room. The roof was raised in the social hall/gymnasium area to provide ample space for athletics and social activity.
