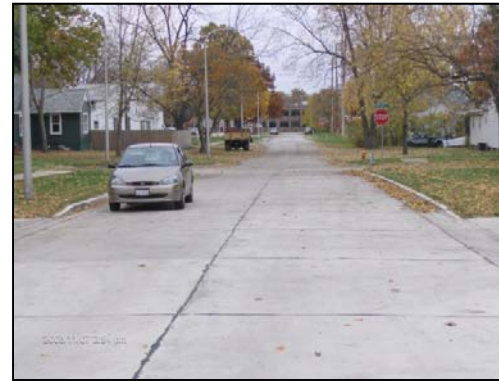


CONCRETE STREET MAINTENANCE PROGRAM - 2009

The City of Champaign Concrete Street Maintenance is a multi-year project which includes the development of a set of design plans and construction supervision of various locations in the City of Champaign IL (Home of the University of Illinois)

The following locations were completed in 2009:

- PCC Patching - Devonshire Drive from Prospect Avenue to Neil Street
- PCC Patching - Windsor Road from Neil Street to First Street
- Street reconstruction - Newbury Road from Robert Drive to Galen Drive
- Street reconstruction - Winston Dr. from Summit Ridge Rd. to Williamsburg Dr.
- Street reconstruction - Thornton Drive from Williamsburg Drive to Hedge Road
- Street reconstruction to Urban standards - Eureka St. from Hickory St. to Market St.
- Street reconstruction to Urban standards - Champaign St. from Eureka to Beardsley Ave.
- Curtis Road Maintenance from Staley Road to Rising Road
