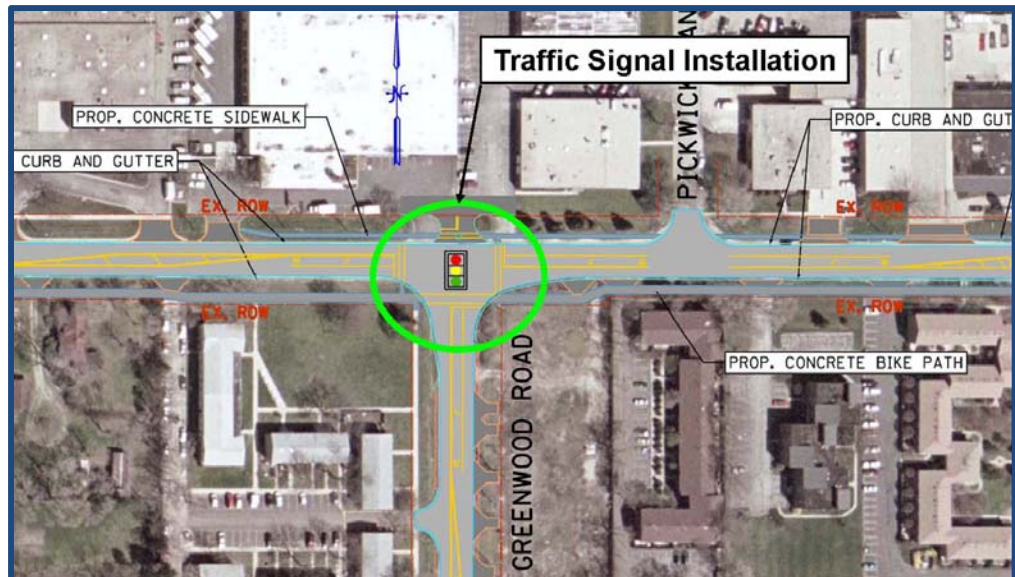


**WEST LAKE AVENUE AND GREENWOOD ROAD
INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS
GLENVIEW, ILLINOIS**



Planning engineering services were provided for this project which consisted of improvements to West Lake Avenue from Pflugsten Road to the Greenwood Road intersection.

The project proposed the widening of West Lake Avenue to a three-lane cross-section, modification of pavement geometry, installation of a new sidewalk and bike path, traffic signal installation, pedestrian signal installation, and new storm sewer installation. The Project required preparation of a project development report including environmental coordination and the preparation of a location drainage study, crash analysis and an intersection design study. The Project also required coordination with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and the Village of Glenview as construction will utilize Surface Transportation Program (STP) and Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) funding.
